Reading Tips

Choose a text of the right level, something that you can understand. If you have to stop to look every word up in a dictionary, this will ruin the pleasure of reading.



Make a note of any new vocabulary in to your vocabulary book.



Try to read regularly, for a short time once a day.



Read what interests YOU. Choose a magazine or book about a subject that you like.
